Evaluation of Students During Exams

1. To be eligible for evaluation, each student should:
 - a. Take and complete the Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) part of the exam on the Educational Portal of Kazan State Medical University on the specified date and time
 - The test taking software calculates the marks obtained and displays it to the student after the attempt has been submitted
 - b. Participate in discussion via Google Meet on the specified date and time with a proper identification document
2. Each faculty member from the examination committee will evaluate the student independently **during the discussion** and an average of 3 marks will then be calculated
 - Eg 1: A student answers three question and any additional cross-questions during the discussion. Faculty member-1, 2 and 3 evaluate and give 78, 85 and 80 marks, respectively. Hence, the average marks on discussion would be 81. (see the image below)
 - Eg. 2: A student answers three question and any additional cross-questions during the discussion. Faculty member-1, 2 and 3 evaluate and give 90, 92 and 90 marks, respectively. In this case, the average comes out to be 90.66. Hence, after rounding it off to the nearest complete number, the marks on discussion would be 91. (see the image below)

3. **Final/Total marks for exam:** $\frac{\text{Marks obtained in MCQs} + \text{Marks obtained in Discussion}}{2}$
 - Eg 1: A student receives 75% in MCQs and 81% in discussion. In this case his exam marks would be 78% (see the image below)
 - Eg. 2: A student receives 60% in MCQs and 91% in discussion. In such case his exam marks would be 75%, after rounding to the nearest complete number (see the image below)
